Friends of Ōwhiro Stream (FOOS) shows the southern end of Ōwhiro Stream

FOOS has been working to restore and protect the entire Ōwhiro stream, the only un piped stream flowing to the south coast from Wellington City. It is the primary freshwater feed into the Taputeranga marine reserve. It provides important habitat for aquatic animals and the surrounding bush acts as a valuable connecting corridor between places such as Zealandia and the town belt.

This group has planted 25,000 native plants on the Island Bay sand dunes since 2003. They have also removed huge quantities of Marram grass and other invasive weeds and continue to carry out a vigilant weeding programme through the areas they have already planted to ensure that natives are not threatened by re-infestation.
